BACKGROUND

- Northeast Ramapo Comprehensive Plan Amendment / GEIS: Adopted July 2022
- Comprehensive Plan Update for remaining unincorporated areas: Monsey, Hillcrest, and Western Ramapo
 - Update of 2004 Town-wide
 Comprehensive Plan



WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN?

- A guide for the future of a community
- Broad in nature
- Addresses Community-wide topics
- A Document, maps, illustrations that:
 - 1. Evaluate the **Current** State
 - 2. Identify the Desired Future State
 - 3. Determine a general Action Plan
 - 4. Describe how to Implement
- Guided by NYS Town Law Article 16 §272-a

- Draft Comprehensive Plan / GEIS
- SEQR Requirements



SEQR PROCESS REVIEW

- SEQR is the State Environmental Quality Review Act (6 NYCRR Part 617)
- Intent is to BALANCE social, economic and environmental factors in the decision-making process
- A Town comprehensive plan or amendment is subject to SEQR (Town Law §272-a.8)
- A Town comprehensive plan can serve as or be accompanied by a Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS)




